phluby: NeoOffice is installed with full support for multiple users

Carlo Gandolfi: why is not Universal?

phluby: To support multiple users on the same machine, NeoOffice must install its files with protected permissions to ensure that all users can share the application

Edward Peterlin: Universal - two reasons, first the OpenOffice.org build system (what we use to make the application from source code) doesn't support this like Apple's tools

Edward Peterlin: Universal 2 - the application would be nearly twice its current size

phluby: ...and the current download for one platform is 130MB

phluby: Even if we could get the OpenOffice.org build system to build a binary, we would have a 260MB

download. (4)

Edward Peterlin: ...and we already probably use terabytes of bandwidth a month and our mirrors might not

like it if we doubled it 😃

phluby: This is also why we have separate language pack installers

Carlo Gandolfi: OS X minimum required?

Edward Peterlin: 10.3

phluby: If you have 10.3, we recommend that you use 10.3.9. Carlo Gandolfi: here are some "eary Acces program" users

Carlo Gandolfi: they ask if you can eat each day (!!)

phluby: Yes. (9)

Edward Peterlin: I have a full time job other than Neo that keeps me fed and housed, but bugfixing doesn't

leave me that much time to eat $\stackrel{\text{\tiny \mbox{\tiny W}}}{=}$

phluby: Thanks to the Early Access members, we have enough money for me to work on NeoOffice full time

through the end of 2006.

Carlo Gandolfi: On intel machine Neo start faster than PPC

phluby: Yes. IMHO, the Intel chip is much faster than most PPC chips Carlo Gandolfi: Why? it depends only by cpu or aslo by code?

Edward Peterlin: mostly CPU

phluby: The code is the same for Intel and PPC. phluby: Faster CPU and Java is slightly faster on Intel

Edward Peterlin: the Apple Intel based MacBooks also have a much better design than the older PowerPC

based laptops

Edward Peterlin: and the downloads of the AquaBeta 3 patches seem to indicate that a good number of

people are continuing to use it (!)

Edward Peterlin: the numbers on trinity (which handles the optional registration) have also been increasing faster as well

Edward Peterlin: (numbers = simultaneous number of unique IP addresses within the last 5 minutes)

Carlo Gandolfi: is wysiwyg?

Edward Peterlin: I'm not sure if this project might work access: http://mdbtools.sourceforge.net/

phluby: Yes. You can open HTML files in NeoOffice and edit them.

Edward Peterlin: there is the "web wizard" for creating webpages...File > New > HTML document

phluby: Or, you can use the File -> Save As menu to save any document to HTML

Edward Peterlin: it won't be totally WYSIWYG, but it's as close as it can get
